**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE:**

William Campbell was born on the Hawksbill Creek in Page County, Virginia and his family later moved to Timberville. In 1852 he married Miss Rebecca Phillips of Mt. Clifton, Shenandoah County, VA.

Mr. Campbell worked for Mr. Abram Garber and lived in Mr. Garber's tenant house located near Mt. Olivet Brethren Church, which is located about five miles northwest of Timberville.

This is a collection of a printer's copy of a book written by Henry R. Campbell about the William Campbell family. Mr. Campbell also wrote a publication about the history of St. John's Lutheran Church in Timberville, VA.
