BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: Shenandoah Conservatory of Music was founded in 1875 by A. P. Funkhouser and located in Dayton, VA. In the late 1950's the college moved to Winchester, VA and was renamed Shenandoah University.

Catherine Walker from Schuyler, Virginia is the May Queen of May 1933 who is seated in the photograph with her attendants. Vivian Kiser from Roanoke, Virginia is the May Queen of May 1934 shown standing in the photograph with her attendants.

Edgar Bartley was a teacher at Turner Ashby High School for a number of years and also served as Mayor of Dayton and recorder of the council. Virginia Bartley's father was James L. Ruebush, owner of Shenandoah Press, who published the Shenandoah College bulletins.

SCOPE AND CONTENT: Photocopies of programs and bulletins from Shenandoah College and Conservatory of Music in Dayton, VA. The originals of these programs were printed by Shenandoah Press, which was owned by James L. Reubush.
