BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: The Massanetta Springs Historic District is a retreat in Rockingham County, Virginia, administered by the Presbyterian Synod of Virginia, and chiefly associated with the Massanetta Springs Summer Bible Conference Encampment. The district includes the Hotel (1910), Hudson Auditorium (1922) and Camp Massanetta (1955-56). A Methodist camp existed at the site, originally known as Taylor's Springs, from 1816.
