BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: Good's Mill was named after Mr. Samuel Good who operated a flour mill. The mill, which was operated by water power, was burned during the Civil War but was rebuilt by Mr. Good. Located across the road was a grocery and dry goods store operated by Mr. M. J. Meyerhoeffer and his two sons, Joe and Ben which was established around 1892. Across from the store was a building used by the Mill Creek Band and Drama Club. Below the store along the creek was a blacksmith shop and garage operated by Mr. Edward Kennedy and son George. Before 1900, John Michael operated a wagon, carriage and buggy shop. The Goods Mill Post Office was established in 1871 and the first postmaster was Samuel Good.

SCOPE AND CONTENT: Genealogical research papers relating to Goods Mill families, the Joseph Good family, and other related families in Harrisonburg as well as Page county; various funeral booklets for Rockingham County citizens.
